OBJECTIVES.

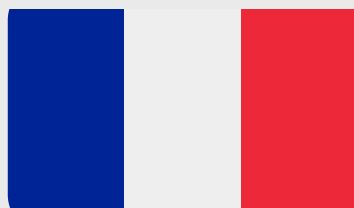
Exchange ideas through the stories of the past and current Resistance.

Provide the participants with an opportunity to take part in the local Eurolys project. It is a project born from the idea of the Colle del Lys aps Resistance Committee that, from 1996 until today, has led many young people to get to know about the history of the Colle del Lys massacre, which happened on July 2nd 1944 in the area, where a Partisan brigade was fighting.

Create a chance for young people to explore and exchange their ideas and understandings of what democracy is, what European values mean to them, and how we can strengthen solidarity through building a common vision of the future together.

During many years, testimonies of the period and survivors alternated their voices to share their stories with the young people taking part in the annual commemoration that was organized by many municipalities of the Metropolitan city of Turin

WEATHER IN TORINO IN JULY :

July in Turin is another warm summer month, with temperatures in the range of an average low of 16.9°C and an average high of 27.9°C. Also, Turin may be a bit wet during July, so please be sure to pack your umbrella to stay dry

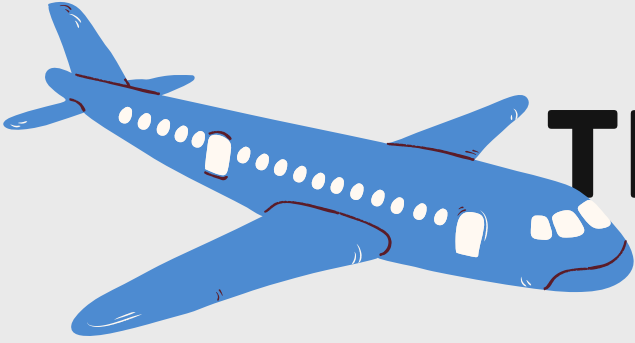
WHAT TO PACK:

Important for the camping days: Please bring your sleeping bag! That's gonna be fun! Bring comfortable and warm clothes for the activities, a raincoat and a wind jacket, slipper socks, a reusable water bottle, and games/music instruments you want to share during freetime. Bring a hat/ cap, sunglasses, sunscreen, eye mask and/or earplugs for sleeping. Comfortable hiking shoes and/ or sandals, as well as hiking clothes. Mosquitos spray might be needed as well!

WHAT ELSE TO BRING:

Some delights, sweets or desserts from your country. Let's explore our cultures! You might also need some costumes or element for a role play we will have in the mountains - imagine you are a partisan and dress accordingly!

Remember - no need to buy anything, just bring what you have, or what you can create, borrow or reuse!



TRAVEL ●

You can arrive 2 days before the activity or depart 2 days after, if you want to spend more time in Italy on your own. Accommodation costs and food for the extra days is not covered by the project funds.

Please make sure to arrive till 3 PM on the first day of the program (gathering spot: Torino Porta Susa).

You can easily reach Torino by train (<https://www.trenitalia.com/>) or Flixbus (<https://global.flixbus.com/>).

Torino also has an airport, but you can check Milano and Bergamo flight connections too.

Your organization can help you find the best solution. Choose your itinerary and share it with us.



Please check with us before purchasing and don't book any ticket without our expressed confirmation. According to our National Agency rules, we can't reimburse taxis or private cars.

Only public transport will be accepted.

FINANCIAL CONDITIONS AND REIMBURSEMENT.

The program is granted with the financial support of the European Commission and the ERASMUS+ Youth Programme. Therefore, accommodation, food, local transport and program activities will be covered by the project budget.

We would highly recommend considering flexible flight tickets as an option for securing yourself from changes or cancellations when unexpected things happen.

According to Erasmus+ Distance Calculator, here is the maximum travel cost available for each participant:

France: 275€ per participant - 320€ in case of green travel
Georgia: 360€ per participant - 410€ in case of green travel
Germany: 180€ per participant - 210€ in case of green travel
Ukraine: 275€ per participant - 320€ in case of green travel
Slovenia: 275€ per participant - 320€ in case of green travel
Spain: 275€ per participant - 320€ in case of green travel

Travel costs will be reimbursed to the sending organizations a minimum of 3 months after the mobility and only upon the completion of the mobility tool survey.

Remember to keep all original travel documents and receipts in order to get the reimbursement.
